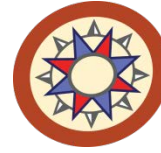

# PAUL L. FOSTER

KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Paul Foster is the founder and former Executive Chairman of Western Refining, Inc. He currently serves on the Board of Directors for Andeavor, one of the leading refining, marketing, and logistics companies in the nation.

Mr. Foster is the Chairman of The University of Texas System Board of Regents and previously served as the Chairman of the University of Texas Investment Management Company (UTIMCO). He also served as a member of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and the Texas Business Leadership Council.

He serves as a Board Member of the El Paso branch of the Dallas Federal Reserve Bank and is on the Board of Directors of WestStar Bank in El Paso. Mr. Foster was the founding Chairman of El Paso Regional Economic Development Corporation (REDCo), and now serves on the Executive Committee of the Borderplex Regional Economic Alliance. He is a former member of the Young Presidents' Organization (where he and his wife, Alejandra de la Vega Foster, met), and he is a current member of the World Presidents' Organization.

Mr. and Mrs. Foster are cofounders of MountainStar Sports Group, owners of the El Paso Chihuahuas and FC Juarez. They have been exceptional supporters of this community and region. Because of their generosity, together and individually, El Paso has the Paul L. Foster School of Medicine, the Foster-Stevens Basketball Complex at UTEP, La Mano Amiga, an operations facility for El Pasoans Fighting Hunger, and the Foster Tree House Playground at the El Paso City Zoo – just to name a few of their philanthropic efforts for the region.

Mr. Foster continues to be a catalyst in El Paso's Downtown revitalization. He purchased and restored several buildings in what is now the Mills Plaza District, always with a goal of keeping intact the historical significance of those properties. He will soon begin another project, the restoration of the landmark Plaza Hotel in Downtown El Paso.

Mr. Foster has received the Baylor University Distinguished Alumni Award, was inducted into the 2013 Class of the Texas Business Hall of Fame, and in 2007 and 2013 was presented with the City of El Paso's Conquistador Award. He was named El Pasoan of the Year twice, inducted into the El Paso Business Hall of Fame, and was named as El Paso's Entrepreneur of the Year.
